A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To honor Paul A. Quander, Jr. as the recipient of the Outstanding Service Award for Career Accomplishments Promoting Excellence in Study, Practice and Judicial Processes of Law from the Sigma Delta Tau Legal Fraternity.

WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. is a native Washingtonian and a Ward 7 resident;

WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. is an honors graduate of both Virginia State University and Howard University School of Law;

WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. has provided more than 25 years of service to the citizens of the District of Columbia in a variety of capacities, most of which were in the criminal justice sector;

WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. started his public service career as a Staff Attorney for the Neighborhood Legal Services Program;

WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. also worked as Assistant Attorney General for the District of Columbia in what was then known as the Office of the Corporation Council, where he prosecuted juvenile offenders and represented District of Columbia agencies and personnel in civil actions in the Juvenile Section, Civil Division, and as Section Chief of the Correctional Litigation Section;

WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. became the Deputy Director of the D.C. Department of Corrections, where he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of eight prisons, two detention facilities and several community correctional centers;

34 WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. continued in his legal career in service for more than
35 seven years as Assistant U.S. Attorney for the District of Columbia, investigating and trying the
36 most serious and violent criminal offenders and organizations;

38 WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. was appointed Executive Director of the District of
39 Columbia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (CJCC), an organization that serves as the
40 forum for identifying issues and their solutions, proposing actions and facilitating cooperation
41 that will improve public safety in the District of Columbia for its residents, visitors, victims and
42 offenders;

44 WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. served as the presidentially appointed Director of the
45 Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA), responsible for approximately
46 15,000 men and women who were being supervised on probation, parole or supervised release;

48 WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. is presently the Deputy Mayor for Public Safety and
49 Justice, where he is responsible for the coordination and supervision of all District of Columbia
50 public safety agencies; and

52 WHEREAS, Paul A. Quander, Jr. is a 2014 recipient of the Outstanding Service Award
53 for Career Accomplishments Promoting Excellence in the Study, Practice and Judicial Processes
54 of the Law, an honor bestowed by the Sigma Delta Tau Legal Fraternity.
