A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To recognize, honor and express our overwhelming gratitude to Tony Cibel, owner of Tony and Joe's Seafood Place at Georgetown's Washington Harbour, for his years of dedicated service and many contributions to the citizens and the city of Washington, D.C.

WHEREAS, Thirty years ago Tony Cebil and Joe Renaldi started Tony and Joe's Seafood Place located at Georgetown's Washington Harbour;

WHEREAS, Tony and Joe's Seafood Place opened at Georgetown's Washington Harbour in 1987 and remains the only original restaurant still located at Georgetown's Washington Harbour;

WHEREAS, Tony and Joe's Seafood Place is family owned and operated with three generations currently managing and working in the establishment;

WHEREAS, In 2011, Tony and Joe's was hardest hit in Georgetown flooding sustaining the most damage of any area business impacted by the flood, being under more than 10 feet of water;

WHEREAS, On October 9, 2017 Tony and Joe's will celebrate its 30th Anniversary and Tony Cibel's 80th birthday;

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Tony and Joe's Seafood Place Recognition Resolution of 2017".
