27	WHEREAS, the Gonzaga Varsity 1 team was ranked first in the Washington Post High School
28	Hockey Rankings for the entire 2017-18 season.
29	WHEREAS, in the 2017-18 season 37 of the 61 players in the Gonzaga Ice Hockey Program
30	received All-Academic Honors, achieving a grade point average of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale.
31	WHEREAS, in addition to their feats on the ice, Gonzaga Hockey players are committed to their
32	weekly Study Buddy tutorial and study sessions at the Fort Dupont Ice Arena, with students from the
33	Cornerstone Schools and Sousa Middle School.

35.	the Dominik Pettey Scholarship and has raised over \$215,000 to date for deserving students to attend
