Gomez for her role in building Mary's Center into a visionary institution. WHEREAS, Maria S. Gomez was born in Colombia and immigrated to the United States with her mother at age 13; WHEREAS, Ms. Gomez attended DC Public Schools and earned degrees in Nursing and Public Health from Georgetown University and the University of California, Berkeley; WHEREAS, Ms. Gomez worked as a nurse with the DC Department of Health when she witnessed a large increase in the number of Latin American women who required maternal healthcare after migrating to the United States to escape dangerous conditions in their home countries: WHEREAS, Ms. Gomez and healthcare advocates founded Mary's Center in 1988 to better meet the needs of mothers; WHEREAS, Mary's Center originally operated out of a basement clinic on Columbia Road, N.W. in Ward 1 before moving to its current headquarters at 2333 Ontario Road, N.W.; WHEREAS, since its founding in 1988, Mary's Center has grown from serving 200 women annually to providing health care, family literacy, and social services to 50,000 men, women, and children from 50 different countries at 8 locations each year; WHEREAS, Mary's Center has committed to a social change model centered around the provision of integrated healthcare, social services, and education—regardless of participants' ability to pay; WHEREAS, Mary's Center serves as an invaluable resource for the neighborhood

surrounding its headquarters in Ward 1 and the healthcare system of the entire Washington

metropolitan area;
