

A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

April 5, 2020

To recognize and honor the Georgetown Day School girls basketball team, 2021/2022 DCSAA Class A girls basketball champions.

WHEREAS, Georgetown Day School is a private high school in northwest Washington, D.C.;

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Day School Grasshoppers compete in the District of Columbia State Athletic Association and the Mid-Atlantic Athletic Conference;

WHEREAS, the Hoppers, who were 24-4 overall this season and 11-2 in league play, advanced to the DCSAA championship game after defeating Archbishop Carroll in the semi-finals. Georgetown Day School faced Banneker High School in the championship game;

WHEREAS, Georgetown Day School controlled the game, building up to a nine-point lead at halftime. The Hoppers extended their lead in the third and fourth quarters, winning the DCSAA championship 59 to 26;

WHEREAS, Zania Socka, sophomore forward for Georgetown Day School, was named the championship game MVP, compiling 19 points and 13 blocks;

WHEREAS, seniors like Aaliyah Ojeda-Brown and Sofia Greenfield, the 2 team captains, were integral to the success of the Hoppers this season;

WHEREAS, Coach Pam Stanfield, who is in her eighth season at Georgetown Day School, is a key leader in reinvigorating the Georgetown Day School program, culminating in the DCSAA championship.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Georgetown Day School Girls Basketball DCSAA Class A Championship Recognition Resolution of 2022”.
