

21 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

24 To recognize and celebrate the leadership and meaningful contributions of Chris and Tori
25 Plummer as long-time, dedicated Ward 8 residents and small business owners who served
26 the international community by dedicating a school to students in West Africa.

28 WHEREAS, Chris and Tori (Hawkins) Plummer both grew up in Ward 8, met as
29 teenagers, and later married;

30
31 WHEREAS, Chris Plummer attended Hendley Elementary, Patricia R. Harris
32 Educational Center, and Eastern Senior High School;

34 WHEREAS, Tori (Hawkins) Plummer attended Leckie Elementary, Thomas Jefferson
35 Junior High (VA) and Duke Ellington School of the Arts, followed by Clark Atlanta University,
36 Bowie State University and Trinity Washington University;

38 WHEREAS, Chris and Tori Plummer own a successful business dedicated to local and
39 citywide construction and residential renovations;

41 WHEREAS, the Plummers partnered with GapBusters Inc., an organization that has
42 served DMV youth for 22 years and now Ghana, to dedicate a school for children in Koforidua,
43 Ghana;

45 WHEREAS, the Plummers lead school renovations that included the building of a
46 multipurpose room with a full-service kitchen and new bathrooms. Before these renovations, the
47 school lacked running water and bathrooms;

49 WHEREAS, Tori Plummer organized a library, playground, and summer STEM program
50 for students with the aid of donations to GapBusters, Inc.;

52 WHEREAS, the Plummers have been traveling to Koforidua for three years to volunteer
53 their services to students and families;

55 WHEREAS, the Plummer’s three children are also growing up in Ward 8 and
56 volunteering their time for charitable causes;

58 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
59 resolution may be cited as the “Chris and Tori Plummer Recognition Resolution of 2022”.

61 Sec. 2. The Council of the District of Columbia recognizes and celebrates the leadership
62 and meaningful contributions of Chris and Tori Plummer, as two long-time Ward 8 residents, for
63 their generosity in service to West African students in Ghana.

65 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first date of publication in
66 the District of Columbia Register.
