19 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

21 To recognize two young residents of Ward 3, Lenox Serrette and Nathan Ehrenberg, for their
22 recent achievements in the world of chess.

23 WHEREAS, Lenox Serrette is a Ward 3 resident and a student at Alice Deal Middle
24 School;

25 WHEREAS, Lenox Serrette has represented the District in the Rockefeller Tournament of
26 Elementary Champions for four consecutive years, and at the 2023 tournament, Lenox placed
27 thirteenth out of fifty-one competitors, earning the title of the top-scoring player with a US Chess
28 Federation rating under 1500;

29 WHEREAS, at age eleven, Lenox Serrette has demonstrated immense talent and potential
30 in the game of chess;

31 WHEREAS, Nathan Ehrenberg is a Ward 3 resident and a student at School Without
32 Walls;

33 WHEREAS, this year, at age fourteen, Nathan Ehrenberg became the youngest US Chess
34 Federation-certified “Local” Tournament Director in the history of the District, Maryland, and
35 Virginia;

36 WHEREAS, Nathan Ehrenberg has demonstrated a deep commitment to the creation and
37 growth of a vibrant chess community in the District; and

38 WHEREAS, the achievements of Lenox Serrette and Nathan Ehrenberg serve to inspire the
39 youth of the District to pursue their passions;

40 RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this
41 resolution be cited as the “Lenox Serrette and Nathan Ehrenberg Achievements in Chess
42 Ceremonial Recognition Resolution of 2023”.

43 Sec. 2. The Council of the District of Columbia recognizes and honors Lenox Serrette and
44 Nathan Ehrenberg for their achievements in the world of chess.

45 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first date of publication in the
46 District of Columbia Register.
