15 To recognize the many and varied contributions that the Mission Group has made to the District
16 of Columbia on the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the Mission Group's Dupont

18 WHEREAS, 2024 marks the 10th anniversary of Mission Dupont, which was opened by
19 Fritz Brogan and Reed Landry at 1606 20th Street Northwest, in the heart of the nation's capital;

20 WHEREAS, with its offerings of daily happy hour, brunch on the patio, and numerous
21 event spaces, Mission Dupont has been a gathering spot for Dupont residents and a staple for
22 District of Columbia residents and visitors alike;

23 WHEREAS, guests have enjoyed over 2.3 million delicious meals at Mission locations
24 across the District over the past decade;

25 WHEREAS, Mission Dupont has served everyone, from world leaders to tourists to
26 neighbors, with a welcoming smile;

27 WHEREAS, Mission Dupont offers delicious tacos and memorable margaritas and is
28 ranked as one of the best and most popular Tex-Mex restaurants in the District;

29 WHEREAS, Mission Dupont was the first location opened by the Mission Group, which
30 has since grown to become one of the largest restaurant groups in the District;

31 WHEREAS, the Mission Group currently operates restaurants in five locations across
32 three wards, including Mission Navy Yard, The Admiral, SALAZAR, and Royal Sands; and

33 WHEREAS, Mission Dupont will celebrate the "Decade in Dupont" on March 7th, 2024.

34 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
35 resolution may be cited as the “Mission Dupont 10th Anniversary Celebration Recognition
36 Resolution of 2024”.
