

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, proposed rules to provide for termination of resuscitation in the field by paramedics and remote pronouncement of death by certain medical doctors following termination of resuscitation by a certified 911 paramedic.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Emergency Medical Services Regulations Approval Emergency Approval Resolution of 2016".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 24 of the Emergency Medical Services Act of 2008, effective March 25, 2009 (D.C. Law 17-357; D.C. Official Code § 7-2341.23), the Mayor, on November 22, 2016, transmitted to the Council proposed rules to provide for termination of resuscitation in the field by paramedics and remote pronouncement of death by certain medical doctors following termination of resuscitation by a certified 911 paramedic. The Council approves the proposed rules published at 63 DCR 011660 to amend Section 526 of Chapter 5 of Title 29 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. The Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, to the Mayor,
