The agency Chief Financial Officer has certified funds are available in the not-to-exceed amount of \$10 million for option year two from December 8, 2016 through December 7, 2017.



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A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16 to Contract No. CW32705 with Tetra Tech, Inc. to provide services pursuant to the requirements of the Anacostia River Toxics Remediation Act of 2014 and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16 to Contract No. CW32705 with Tetra Tech, Inc., Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16 to Contract No. 32705 with Tetra Tech, Inc., to provide services pursuant to the requirements of the Anacostia River Toxics Remediation Act of 2014 (D.C. Law 20-155; D.C. Official Code § 8-104.31) and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16.

34 (b) On December 5, 2016, the District issued Modification No. 6 to partially
35 exercise option year 2 for the period of December 8, 2016 through February 14, 2017, in
36 the not-to-exceed amount of \$970,000.

37 (c) On February 13, 2017, the District issued Modification No. 7 to exercise
38 another partial option for the period of February 15, 2017 through March 14, 2017, at no
39 additional cost.

40 (d) On March 14, 2017, the District issued Modification No. 8 to exercise a third
41 partial option for option year 2 for the period of March 15, 2017, through April 14, 2017,
42 at no additional cost.

43 (e) On April 12, 2017, the District issued Modification No. 9 to extend option
44 year 2 for the period of April 15, 2017 through May 14, 2017, again at no additional cost.

45 (f) On May 14, 2017, the District issued Modification No. 13 to exercise another
46 partial option for the period of May 15, 2017 through June 14, 2017, at no additional cost.

47 (g) On June 14, 2017, the District issued Modification No. 15 to extend the
48 contract from June 15, 2017 through July 14, 2017, at no additional cost.

49 (h) On June 14, 2017, the District issued Modification No. 16 which modified the
50 monthly management fixed fee to \$37,000 per month for option year 2.

51 (i) By proposed Modification No. 14, the District will exercise the remainder of
52 option year 2 for the period of July 15, through December 7, 2017, in the not-to-exceed
53 amount of \$10,000,000.

54 (j) The aggregate not-to-exceed value of Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15,

55 and 16 will exceed the \$ 1 million threshold pursuant to section 451 of the District of
56 Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official
57 Code § 1-204.51). As such, Council approval is now required.

58 (k) Approval of Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16, in the aggregate
59 not-to exceed amount of \$ 10,000,000 is necessary to ensure performance of the to
60 provide services performed to satisfy the requirements of the Anacostia River Toxics
61 Remediation Act of 2014 (D.C. Law 20-155; D.C. Official Code § 8-104.31), and to
62 compensate Tetra Tech, Inc., for services provided and to be provided pursuant to the
63 contract.

64 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
65 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
66 necessary that the Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16 to Contract No.
67 CW32705 with Tetra Tech, Inc., Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of
68 2017 be adopted after a single reading.

69 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
