

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 19, 20 and 21 to Contract No. DCFA-2012-C-0466/CW47358 with Allied Universal Security Services to provide security services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. DCFA-2012-C-0466/CW47358 with Allied Universal Security Services Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2017”.

Sec. 2 (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 19, 20 and 21 to Contract No. DCFA-2012-C-0466/CW47358 with Allied Universal Security Services to provide security services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 19, 20 and 21.

(b) By Modification No. 18 dated June 20, 2016, the District of Columbia Public Schools (“DCPS”) exercised option year four of Contract No. DCFA-2012-C-0466/CW47358 in the estimated amount of \$19,895,464.57. Council approved Modification No. 18.

1 (c) By Modification No. 19 dated September 22, 2016, DCPS increased the  
2 estimated amount of option year four by \$214,610.93.

3 (d) By Modification No. 20 dated March 21, 2017, DCPS increased the estimated  
4 amount of option year four by \$900,068.80.

5 (e) Modification No.21 will increase the estimated amount of option year four by  
6 \$270,008.44. The total estimated increased amount for option year four is \$1,384,688.17.

7 (f) Council approval is necessary since these modifications increase the contract  
8 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

9 (g) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
10 Without this approval, Allied Universal Security Services cannot be paid for goods and  
11 services provided in excess of \$1 million of the previously approved amount for the  
12 contract period July 9, 2016 through July 8, 2017.

13 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
14 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it  
15 necessary that the Modifications to Contract No. DCFA-2012-C-0466/CW47358 with  
16 Allied Universal Security Services Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act  
17 of 2017 be adopted after a single reading.

18 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
