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A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 7, 9, and 10 to Contract No. CW37196 with Unity Health Care, Inc. to provide comprehensive medical, behavioral health, pharmacy and dental services to inmates housed in the Central Detention Facility, the Correctional Treatment Facility, and Central Cell Block, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under these modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW37196 with Unity Health Care, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 7, 9, and 10 to Contract No. CW37196 with Unity Health Care, Inc. to provide comprehensive medical, behavioral health, pharmacy and dental services to inmates housed in the Central Detention Facility, the Correctional Treatment Facility, and Central Cell Block, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under Modification Nos. 7, 9, and 10.

(b) On August 8, 2017, the Council approved the exercise of option year two of Contract No. CW37196 in the amount of \$22,444,402.

1 (c) By Modification No. 7, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (“OCP”),
2 on behalf of the Department of Corrections, increased the amount for option year two by
3 \$554,646.

4 (d) By Modification No. 9, the OCP increased the amount for option year two by
5 \$445,354.

6 (e) Modification No. 10 is now necessary to increase the amount for option year
7 two by \$3,689,480, and increase the total amount for option year two to \$27,133,882.

8 (f) Council approval is necessary since these modifications increase the value of
9 the contract by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

10 (g) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
11 Without this approval, Unity Health Care, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services
12 provided in excess of \$1 million beyond the previously approved amount for option year
13 two.

14 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
15 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
16 necessary that the Modifications to Contract No. CW37196 with Unity Health Care, Inc.
17 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2018 be adopted after a single
18 reading.

19 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
