

A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

September 18, 2018

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve multiyear Contract No. CW63154 with the Defense Logistics Agency in the not-to-exceed amount of \$15 million to provide pharmaceutical drugs and related items to customers receiving direct care from the Department of Behavioral Health.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. CW63154 Approval Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2018”.

Sec. 2. (a) The Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Behavioral Health, proposes to enter into a multiyear contract with the Defense Logistics Agency to provide pharmaceutical drugs and related items to customers receiving direct care from the Department of Behavioral Health.

(b) The not-to-exceed value of this multiyear contract with the Defense Logistics Agency would be \$15 million.

(c) Approval of the multiyear contract is necessary to allow the District to continue to receive the benefit of these vital goods and services from the Defense Logistics Agency without interruption.

(d) These critical goods and services can only be obtained through an award of the multiyear contract to the Defense Logistics Agency.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Contract No. CW63154 Emergency Approval Resolution of 2018 be adopted on an emergency basis.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
