

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Violence Fatality Review Committee Clayton Rosenberg Confirmation Resolution of 2019". Sec. 2. The Council of the District of Columbia confirms the appointment of: Mr. Clayton Rosenberg 905 6th St SW Washington, DC 20024 (Ward 6) as a representative from an organization providing services to secondary victims of homicide or suicide member to the Violence Fatality Review Committee, established by section 3042 of the Fatality Review Committee Amendment Act of 2018, effective October 30, 2018 (D.C.
