Pursuant to D. C. Official Code §2-352.02a, enclosed for consideration by the Council of the District of Columbia is the proposed multiyear legislation, emergency declaration, emergency resolution, and proposed contract action for Contract CFOPD-14-C-031 with Fast Enterprises, LLC. The proposed contract action exercises the two (2), one (1) year option periods from July 2, 2019 through July 1, 2021 in the amount not to exceed \$12,674,467.

The purpose of the proposed contract action with Fast Enterprises, LLC is to exercise the option periods with upgraded maintenance and support and continued hosting services and additional resources in the option periods for the Modernized Integrated Tax System (MITS) for the District.

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to Modification 13 of Contract No. CFOPD-14-C-031 with Fast Enterprises, LLC to continue to provide upgraded maintenance and support, continuing hosting services and additional resources for the Modernized Integrated Tax System (MITS) for the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. CFOPD-14-C-031, Modernized Integrated Tax System Extension Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2019”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve the two (2), one (1) year options of Contract No. CFOPD-14-C-031 with Fast Enterprises, LLC to continue to provide upgraded maintenance and support, continuing hosting services and additional resources for the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue.

(b) The Office of the Chief Financial Officer, at its sole discretion, may extend the period of this contract for up to two (2), one (1) year option periods, in the maximum not-to-exceed amount of \$12,674,467.

(f) Council approval is necessary because proposed Modification 13 exercises two option periods that result in a multiyear extension, and is in excess of \$1 million. Council

1 approval is further necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services and to allow Fast
2 Enterprises, LLC to continue performance under the contract.

3 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
4 enumerated in Section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
5 Contract No. CFOPD-14-C-031 Extension Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency
6 Act of 2019 be adopted after a single reading.

7 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
