29	Sec. 2. (a) Immediate legislation is required to ensure that the Washington Metropolitan
30	Opportunity Academy ("WMOA"), located at 300 Bryant Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.,
31	20001, remains open for the 2020-2021 school year. On January 23, 2020, the Mayor and the
32	Chancellor of the District of Columbia Public Schools ("DCPS") announced plans to close
33	WMOA at the end of the 2019-2020 school year.
34	(b) DCPS's decision to close WMOA was made without its students, parents, and
35	community having any say in discussions about the best path forward for students.

- 36 (c) WMOA has a small, specialized student population, that enables students to receive 37 the additional time and support they need to ensure future success.
 - (d) WMOA provides students with access to programs and support that students would not receive at other schools.
 - (e) WMOA is the only opportunity academy in the District that includes grades 7 and 8.
- 41 (e) Immediate action by the Council is necessary to prevent WMOA from closing and
 42 displacing students without input from its community and the students who need WMOA's
 43 services.
 - Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute an emergency making it necessary that the "Washington Metropolitan Opportunity Academy Emergency Amendment Act of 2020" be adopted after a single reading.
- Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
