Enclosed for consideration by the Council of the District of Columbia is proposed emergency legislation, "Contract No. DCAM-20-CS-RFP-0005 with GCS-SIGALIGRUNLEY Joint Venture Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of2020", and the accompanying declaration resolution, to approve the proposed Design-Build Agreement for Redevelopment of the St. Elizabeths East Campus - Parcel 6 Parking Garage (DCAM-20-CS-RFP-0005) (the "Contract") with GCS-SIGALIGRUNLEY Joint Venture (the "Contractor") in the amount of \$25,000,000.00 and, to authorize payment to the Contractor for design-build services received and to be received under the Letter Contract and the proposed Contract.

The Department of General Services seeks Council approval for the proposed Contract to increase the initial Letter Contract amount of \$950,000.00 to a not-to-exceed amount of \$25,000,000.00.

The Chief Financial Officer has certified that funding is available for the increased Contract amount of \$25,000,000.00.

In addition to the Letter Contract and proposed Contract attached are: (i) a contract summary; (ii) a fiscal certification; (iii) memoranda and/or certifications of legal sufficiency; and (iv) a Clean Hands Certification for the Contractor.

25	this resolution may be cited as the "Contract No. DCAM-20-CS-RFP-0005 with GCS-
26	SIGAL GRUNLEY Joint Venture Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency
27	Declaration Resolution of 2020."
28	Sec. 2.(a) There exists an immediate need to approve the Design-Build
29	Agreement for Redevelopment of the St. Elizabeths East Campus - Parcel 6 Parking
30	Garage (DCAM-20-CS-RFP-0005) (the "Contract") between the Department of General
31	Services (the "Department") and GCS-SIGAL GRUNLEY Joint Venture (the
32	"Contractor") and to authorize payment in an aggregate amount of \$25,000,000.00 for
33	design-build services received and to be received under the Contract.
34	(b) On May 8, 2020, the Department executed a Letter Contract in the amount of
35	\$950,000.00. The value of Letter Contract was less than \$1 million; thus, it did not

require Council approval. The amount of the proposed Contract would increase by
 \$24,050,000.00, from \$950,000.00 to \$25,000,000.00.

(c) The amount of the proposed Contract, inclusive of the merged Letter Contract, 3 is in excess of \$1 million during a 12-month period; therefore, Council approval of 4 5 proposed Contract is now required pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-6 7 204.51). (d) In addition, Council approval of the proposed Contract is necessary to 8 authorize the continuation of design-build services for the St. Elizabeths Parking Garage 9 and to compensate the Contractor for design-build services provided and to be provided 10 11 under the proposed Contract. Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the 12 circumstances enumerated in Section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it 13 necessary that the "Contract No. DCAM-20-CS-RFP-0005 with. GCS-14 SIGAL|GRUNLEY Joint Venture Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act 15 of 2020" be adopted after a single reading. 16 17 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

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
