Enclosed for consideration and approval by the Council of the District of Columbia is proposed emergency legislation, the "Contract No. CW80913 with E-One, Inc. Emergency Approval Resolution of 2020" and accompanying declaration resolution, to approve multiyear Contract No. CW80913 to provide a new foam unit to the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department. Approval is necessary to allow the District to receive these vital goods and services, and the critical requirements of the District can only be met through an award of the proposed multiyear contract to E-One, Inc.
