A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to provide that expenditures on school-administered theatrical and music performances, including stipends for non-District of Columbia Public Schools employees, shall be allowable expenditures from a school's Student Activity Fund.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021".

Sec. 2. (a) On July 21, 2020, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Emergency Act of 2020, effective August 21, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-379; 67 DCR 9859) ("emergency act"), which expired on November 10, 2020.

(b) On September 22, 2020, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Temporary Act of 2020 ("temporary act"), which is undergoing congressional review, and may not be in effect on January 23, 2021.

(c) On October 6, 2020, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2020 ("congressional review emergency act"), which will expire on January 23, 2021.

(d) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the congressional review emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2021 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
