

A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

May 4, 2021

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification No. 20 and proposed Modification No. 21 to Human Care Agreement No. CW56285 with Community of Hope, Inc., to provide permanent supportive housing program case management services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. CW56285 with Community of Hope, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 20 and proposed Modification No. 21 to Human Care Agreement No. CW56285 with Community of Hope, Inc., to provide permanent supportive housing program case management services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) By Modification No. 20, dated December 1, 2020, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Human Services, exercised partial Option Year 3 for Human Care Agreement No. CW56285 for the period December 1, 2020, through April 30, 2021, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$934,694.75.

(c) Modification No. 21 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of Option Year 3 for the period May 1, 2021, through November 30, 2021, which will increase the total contract not-to-exceed amount for Option Year 3 to \$2,243,267.40.

(d) Council approval is required by section 451(b) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b)), as these modifications increase the contract to more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

(e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services. Without this approval, Community of Hope, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the contract period beginning December 1, 2020, through November 30, 2021.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. CW56285 with Community of Hope, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
