

Ms. Hannah MacIntyre is the Interim Midwifery Division Director, the Midwifery Director of Labor and Delivery, and a Clinical Assistant Professor, and a Certified Nurse Midwife at George Washington University, Medical Faculty Associates.

Ms. MacIntyre has worked as a registered nurse and certified nurse midwife for the past 8 years and has been various leadership and educational roles in the Midwifery Division at GWU for 6 years. Her education and career began in women's health advocacy work in New York City, where she was drawn to working hand-in-hand with women to improve their health and wellbeing. After completing her nursing education, she worked in a clinic in rural Pennsylvania serving a diverse and underserved population providing community-based education on women's health topics.

Ms. MacIntyre returned to DC to complete her education and has been practicing midwifery at George Washington since 2015. In addition to practicing midwifery, Ms. MacIntyre is passionate about community and global health. She volunteers in a teaching role at local organizations and has worked in Haiti to provide health care to rural populations.

A Ward 1 resident and native Washingtonian, Ms. MacIntyre received a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Salisbury University, and a Masters of Science in Nurse-Midwifery/Women's Health Nurse Practitioner from Georgetown University.
