

A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

June 28, 2022

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19 to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax Inc. to provide pick up and processing of solid waste services, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19 to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19 to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax Inc. to provide pick up and processing of solid waste services and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 14, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Public Works, exercised a partial option of the second year of Option Period One of Contract No. CW34843 for \$1 million for the period January 1, 2022, through February 14, 2022.

(c) Modification No. 15 exercised another partial option of the second year of Option Period One for \$3 million for the period February 15, 2022, through June 30, 2022.

(d) Modification No. 16 adjusted the consumer price index for the rates for the option period but did not increase the amount for the partial option period.

(e) Modification No. 17 is an administrative modification.

(f) Modification No. 18 exercised the remainder of the option period through December 31, 2022, and increased the total amount to \$8 million for the second year of Option Period One.

(g) Modification No. 19 is an administrative modification.

(h) Council approval is necessary as these modifications increase the value of the contract by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

(i) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services. Without this approval, Covanta Fairfax Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the period January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Modification Nos. 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19 to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
