A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, and 9 to Contract No. CW93185 with Genuine Parts Company d/b/a/ NAPA Auto Parts to provide operational and logistical management, inventory control, and vehicle parts to the Fire and Emergency Medical Services fleet/apparatus division, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, and 9 to Contract No. CW93185 with Genuine Parts Company d/b/a/ NAPA Auto Parts Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023".

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, and 9 to Contract No. CW93185 with Genuine Parts Company d/b/a/ NAPA Auto Parts to provide operational and logistical management, inventory control, and vehicle parts to the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department's fleet/apparatus division, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) By Modification No. 6, dated August 6, 2022, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of FEMS, exercised a part of option year one of Contract No. CW93185

35 for the period August 6, 2022 through November 5, 2022 in the not-to-exceed amount of
36 \$417,500.

37 (c) By Modification No. 7, dated October 25, 2022, the Office of Contracting and
38 Procurement, on behalf of FEMS, exercised an additional part of option year one of Contract No.
39 CW93185 for the period November 6, 2022 through December 31, 2022 in the additional not-to-
40 exceed amount of \$232,500.

41 (d) By Modification No. 8, dated December 15, 2022, the Office of Contracting and
42 Procurement, on behalf of FEMS, exercised an additional part of option year one of Contract No.
43 CW93185 for the period January 1, 2023 through February 15, 2023 in the additional not-to-
44 exceed amount of \$100,000.

45 (e) Modification No. 9 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year one of
46 Contract No. CW93185 for the period February 16, 2023 through August 5, 2023 in the amount
47 of \$783,000, raising the total not-to-exceed amount for option period one to \$1,533,000.

48 (f) Council approval is required by section 451(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Home
49 Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b)(1)) since
50 these modifications will increase the value of the contract to more than \$1 million during a 12-
51 month period.

52 (g) Approval on an emergency basis is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital
53 services. Without this approval, Genuine Parts Company d/b/a/ NAPA Auto Parts cannot be paid
54 for goods and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the period August 6, 2022 through
55 August 5, 2023.

56 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
57 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the

58 Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, and 9 to Contract No. CW93185 with Genuine Parts Company d/b/a/
59 NAPA Auto Parts Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023 be adopted
60 after a single reading.

61 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
