IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, multiyear Contract No. DCKA-2022-C-0071 with American Traffic Solutions, Inc. d/b/a Verra Mobility to provide leased portable and stationary traffic enforcement systems.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. DCKA-2022-C-0071 with American Traffic Solutions, Inc. d/b/a Verra Mobility Emergency Approval Resolution of 2023.”

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(c)(3)), and section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18- 371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Contract No. DCKA-2022-C-0071 with American Traffic Solutions, Inc. d/b/a Verra Mobility to provide leased portable and stationary traffic enforcement systems for a two-year period from the date of the award in the not-to-exceed amount of \$27,228,000 for the goods and services to be received under the contract.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, to the Mayor.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
