The Council of the District of Columbia confirms the reappointment of: Dr. James Huang 1st Street, NE Washington, DC 20002 (Ward 5) as a public member of the Food Policy Council, established by section 3 of the Food Policy Council and Director Establishment Act of 2014, effective March 10, 2015 (D.C.
