Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Office of Insurance Regulation shall conduct a study to determine whether Broward County with regard to its current insurance market lacks a reasonable degree of competition such that the requirements of s. 627.351(6)(a)3.b.d., Florida Statutes, do not apply in the county. The office may study any other county similarly situated. Each study must consider whether a lack of competition has been found in any adjoining counties and whether the factors that led to any such finding apply in the studied county. The office shall submit a report of its findings concerning Broward County to the Governor, the Chief Financial Officer, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than September 1, 2022. The findings concerning any other county studied under this section shall be presented to the Governor, the Chief Financial Officer, the President of the Senate, and

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26 the Speaker of the House of Representatives within 90 days after the commencement of the study. This section expires December 31, 2022. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
