19	(u) Items that assist in independent living
20	1. The following items, when purchased for noncommercial
21	home or personal use, are exempt from the tax imposed by this

23	a. A bed transfer handle selling for \$60 or less.
24	b. A bed rail selling for \$110 or less.
25	c. A grab bar selling for \$100 or less.
