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meeting all specifications required by the department, which must, at a minimum: (a) Be designed to display the information required in this chapter to be included on a physical license plate; (b) Be designed to be placed on a motor vehicle registered under this chapter in lieu of a physical license plate; (c) Be designed to display any other information that the department, in consultation with law enforcement agencies, determines may improve public safety; and (d) Have been determined by the Department of Transportation to have a display readable by current toll collection systems and current law enforcement automated license plate recognition hardware and software. Section 2. Subsection (6) of section 320.06, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (7), subsection (5) is amended, and a new subsection (6) is added to that section, to read:

(5) The department may conduct a pilot program to evaluate the designs, concepts, and technologies for <u>digital</u> alternative license plates <u>as provided for in subsection (6)</u>. For purposes of the pilot program, the department <u>may shall</u> investigate the feasibility and use of <u>digital</u> alternative license plate technologies <u>that modernize license plates used in this state</u>

104	purpose of evaluating the designs, concepts, and technologies of

109	(b) If the department conducts the pilot program, it must
110	administer the program and allow government-owned motor vehicles
111	registered under this chapter to be equipped with a digital

114	1. The department may contract with digital license plate
115	providers to participate in the pilot program.
116	2. For each digital license plate provider contracted by
117	the department to participate in the pilot program, the
118	department shall select at least two geographic regions of this
119	state and use at least 10 digital license plates in each region.
120	The pilot program must be implemented in at least one urban
121	region and one rural region of this state.
122	3. For each digital license plate provider contracted by
123	the department to participate in the pilot program, the
124	evaluation of the digital license plate designs, concepts, and
125	technologies must conclude within 6 months after the execution

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126	of a contract for participation in the pilot program. Within 8
127	months after the execution of a contract to participate in the
128	pilot program for the evaluation of the digital license plate
129	designs, concepts, and technologies, the department shall make

Physical</u> 163 164 license plates must be renewed in accordance with the 165 requirements of s. 320.06 relating to all fees due on an annual 166 or semiannual basis. 167 The department may contract with digital license plate (b) 168 providers for the issuance of digital license plates, including 169 any services related to the issuance of digital license plates. 170 The contract must include provisions governing the protection of personal and motor vehicle registration data obtained by a 171 172 digital license plate provider in the performance of its 173 services. A digital license plate provider may not sell or share 174 personal or motor vehicle registration data and may not store, 175 sell, or share geolocation data from the use of a digital

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176	license plate. A digital license plate provider that violates
177	this paragraph is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed
178	\$5,000 per occurrence.
179	(c) The department may authorize the display of the motor
180	vehicle's validation on each digital license plate in lieu of
181	the validation sticker. The validation must display the owner's
182	birth month, the license plate number, and the year of
183	expiration or the appropriate renewal period if the owner is not
184	a natural person. The validation must be displayed in the upper
185	right corner of the digital license plate.
186	(d) The department may authorize the use of a digital
187	license plate for electronic toll collection, if such use has
188	been approved by the Department of Transportation or other
189	appropriate tolling authority, or to display a parking permit.
190	(e) The department shall establish procedures for
191	displaying information on a digital license plate, which may
192	include, but not be limited to:
193	1. An emergency alert or other public safety alert issued

Other displays that the department, in consultation 203 with law enforcement agencies, determines are in the interest of 204 public safety. 205 (3) DIGITAL LICENSE PLATE REQUIREMENTS. - A digital license 206 plate issued under this section must: 207 (a) Meet the specifications and requirements adopted under 208 subsection (2). 209 (b) Include the same information required to be included 210 on a physical license plate and legibly display that information 211 at all times and in all light conditions. 212 (c) Have wireless connectivity capability. 213 (4) DIGITAL LICENSE PLATE PROVIDERS.—A digital license 214 plate provider with whom the department contracts shall: 215 Maintain an inventory of digital license plates issued (a) 216 in this state by the digital license plate provider. 217 (b) Make available a digital version of each specialty 218 license plate authorized by the department. 219 (c) If a digital license plate displays a validation, 220 promptly update the display of the validation to reflect the current registration period for the motor vehicle and, upon 221 request of the department, suspend the display of the validation 222 223 or indicate on the digital license plate that the registration 224 for the motor vehicle has expired. 225 (5) DIGITAL LICENSE PLATE CONSUMERS. - In addition to any

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226	fees associated with the purchase of a digital license plate,
227	the consumer is also responsible for paying to the department
228	all applicable motor vehicle fees required by this chapter,
229	including any annual use fees pursuant to s. 320.08056
230	associated with any specialty license plate the consumer wishes
