26 first reading in that house. On each reading, it shall be read 27 by title only, unless one-third of the members present desire it 28 read in full. On final passage, the vote of each member voting 29 shall be entered on the journal. Passage of a bill shall require 30 a majority vote in each house. Each bill and joint resolution 31 passed in both houses shall be signed by the presiding officers 32 of the respective houses and by the secretary of the senate and 33 the clerk of the house of representatives during the session or as soon as practicable after its adjournment sine die. 34
