Section 1. Subsection (10) of section 402.305, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

Minimum standards shall include requirements for child restraints or seat belts and video cameras in vehicles used by child care facilities and large family child care homes to transport children, requirements for annual inspections of the vehicles, limitations on the number of children in the vehicles,

procedures to avoid leaving children in vehicles when transported by the facility <u>or home</u>, and accountability for children transported by the <del>child care</del> facility <u>or home</u>. A child care facility <u>or a large family child care home</u> is not responsible for children when they are transported by a parent or guardian.

(b) A child care facility or a large family child care home shall install a video camera, approved by the department, in each vehicle used by the facility or home to transport children. The facility or home must ensure that the video camera is continuously recording inside each vehicle while transporting children. The department shall adopt by rule minimum standards for the installation and operation of such video cameras and shall maintain a list of approved video cameras that meet or exceed such standards on its website.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
