19	premium, every policy shall be mailed <u>,</u> or delivered <u>, or</u>
20	electronically transmitted to the insured or to the person
21	entitled thereto not later than 60 days after the effectuation
22	of coverage. Electronic transmission of a policy for commercial
23	risks, including, but not limited to, workers' compensation and
24	employers' liability, commercial automobile liability,
25	commercial automobile physical damage, commercial lines
26	residential property, commercial nonresidential property, farm
27	owners' insurance, and the types of commercial lines risks set
28	forth in s. 627.062(3)(d), shall constitute delivery to the

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insured or to the person entitled to delivery, unless the
insured or the person entitled to delivery communicates to the
insurer in writing or electronically that he or she does not
agree to delivery by electronic means. Electronic transmission
shall include a notice to the insured or to the person entitled
to delivery of a policy of his or her right to receive the
policy via United States mail rather than via electronic
transmission. A paper copy of the policy shall be provided to
the insured or to the person entitled to delivery at his or her
request.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.

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
