Basic rights.-All natural persons, female and 19 male alike, are equal before the law and have inalienable 20 rights, among which are the right to enjoy and defend life and 21 liberty, to pursue happiness, to be rewarded for industry, and 22 to acquire, possess, and protect property; except that the 23 ownership, inheritance, disposition and possession of real 24 property by aliens ineligible for citizenship may be regulated or prohibited by law.
