26 appropriation of state funds. 27 By July 1, 2022, the Department of Management Services (4) 28 shall identify and make an appropriate public area available for 29 the construction and the placement of the POW-MIA Vietnam 30 Veterans Bracelet Memorial in Tallahassee, along South Monroe 31 Street and on or near the premises of the Capitol Complex. The 32 department shall consider recommendations by the Vietnam 33 Veterans of America, and the Florida Historical Commission as 34 required pursuant to ss. 265.111(2) and 267.0612(9), regarding 35 the monument's design and placement. In addition, the department 36 shall coordinate with the Division of Historical Resources of 37 the Department of State in determining the monument's design and 38 placement as required under s. 265.111(2).
