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- (3) Annually, each district school board must receive the self-assessment results and recommendations at a publicly noticed district school board meeting to provide the public an opportunity to hear the district school board members discuss and, if necessary, take action on the findings.
- (4) The district school superintendent shall report the self-assessment results and any resulting school board action to the Commissioner of Education within 3 days after the district school board meeting.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
