enforcement agencies in counties with a population of 50,000 or fewer unincarcerated persons to fund drug enforcement and related activities of those agencies in those counties. Such activities may include, but are not limited to, the salaries of investigators, the purchase of equipment and supplies, and training for law enforcement personnel and fire rescue personnel who are responsible for rendering aid to persons victimized by illegal drug trafficking and manufacturing and the clean-up of sites where illegal drugs are manufactured.
