15	Section 1. Section 320.089, Florida Statutes, is amended

30 (1) (a) Each owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for 31 private use or recreational vehicle as specified in s. 32 320.08(9)(c) or (d), which is not used for hire or commercial 33 use, who is a resident of this the state and a veteran of the 34 United States Armed Forces, a World War II Veteran, Woman 35 Veteran, Navy Combat Veteran, Marine Corps Combat Veteran, Air 36 Force Combat Veteran, Navy Submariner, an active or retired 37 member of the Florida National Guard, a survivor of the attack 38 on Pearl Harbor, a recipient of the Purple Heart medal, an 39 active or retired member of any branch of the United States 40 Armed Forces Reserve, or a recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge, Combat Medical Badge, or Combat Action Badge, Combat 41 42 Action Ribbon, Air Force Combat Action Medal, or Distinguished 43 Flying Cross shall, upon application to the department, 44 accompanied by proof of release or discharge from any branch of 45 the United States Armed Forces, proof of active membership or retired status in the Florida National Guard, proof of 46 47 membership in the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association or proof of active military duty in Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, proof 48 of being a Purple Heart medal recipient, proof of active or 49 retired membership in any branch of the United States Armed 50 Forces Reserve, or proof of membership in the Combat 51 52 Infantrymen's Association, Inc., or other proof of being a

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53 recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge, Combat Medical Badge, or Combat Action Badge, Combat Action Ribbon, Air Force Combat 54 55 Action Medal, or Distinguished Flying Cross, and upon payment of 56 the license tax for the vehicle as provided in s. 320.08, shall 57 be issued a license plate as provided by s. 320.06, upon which, 58 in lieu of the serial numbers prescribed by s. 320.06, is shall 59 be stamped with the words "Veteran," "World War II Veteran," "Woman Veteran," "Navy Combat Veteran," "Marine Corps Combat 60 Veteran," "Air Force Combat Veteran," "Navy Submariner," 61 62 "National Guard," "Pearl Harbor Survivor," "Combat-wounded veteran," "U.S. Reserve," "Combat Infantry Badge," "Combat 63 64 Medical Badge," or "Combat Action Badge," "Combat Action 65 Ribbon," "Air Force Combat Action Medal," or "Distinguished Flying Cross," as appropriate, and a likeness of the related 66 campaign medal, ribbon, or badge, followed by the serial number 67 68 of the license plate. Additionally, the Purple Heart plate may have the words "Purple Heart" stamped on the plate and the 69 likeness of the Purple Heart medal appearing on the plate. 70

71 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the (b) 72 contrary, beginning with fiscal year 2002-2003 and annually 73 thereafter, the first \$100,000 in general revenue generated from 74 the sale of license plates issued under this section shall be 75 deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund, as described in s. 296.38(2), to be used for the purposes established by law 76 77 for that trust fund. Any additional general revenue generated 78 from the sale of such plates shall be deposited into the State

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79 Homes for Veterans Trust Fund and used solely to construct, 80 operate, and maintain domiciliary and nursing homes for 81 veterans, subject to the requirements of chapter 216. 82 (C) Any revenue generated from the sale of Woman Veteran 83 license plates shall be deposited into the Operations and 84 Maintenance Trust Fund administered by the Department of 85 Veterans' Affairs pursuant to s. 20.375(3) and are to be used 86 solely for the purpose of creating and implementing programs to 87 benefit woman veterans. Notwithstanding any other provision 88 provisions of law to the contrary, an applicant for a Pearl 89 Harbor Survivor license plate or a Purple Heart license plate 90 who also qualifies for a disabled veteran's license plate under s. 320.084 shall be issued the appropriate special license plate 91 92 without payment of the license tax imposed by s. 320.08. (2) Each owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for 93

94 private use, a truck weighing not more than 7,999 pounds, or a 95 recreational vehicle as specified in s. 320.08(9)(c) or (d), 96 which is not used for hire or commercial use, who is a resident 97 of this the state and who is a former prisoner of war, or his or 98 her their unremarried surviving spouse, shall, upon application 99 therefor to the department, shall be issued a license plate as 100 provided in s. 320.06, on which license plate are stamped with 101 the words "Ex-POW" followed by the serial number. Each 102 application shall be accompanied by proof that the applicant 103 meets the qualifications specified in paragraph (a) or paragraph 104 (b).

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105 A citizen of the United States who served as a member (a) of the Armed Forces of the United States or the armed forces of 106 107 a nation allied with the United States who was held as a 108 prisoner of war at such time as the Armed Forces of the United 109 States were engaged in combat, or his or her their unremarried 110 surviving spouse, may be issued the special license plate 111 provided for in this subsection without payment of the license 112 tax imposed by s. 320.08.

113 A person who was serving as a civilian with the (b) 114 consent of the United States Government, or a person who was a 115 member of the Armed Forces of the United States while he or she 116 who was not a United States citizen who and was held as a prisoner of war when the Armed Forces of the United States were 117 118 engaged in combat, or his or her their unremarried surviving 119 spouse, may be issued the special license plate provided for in 120 this subsection upon payment of the license tax imposed by s. 121 320.08.

122 (3) Each owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for 123 private use, a truck weighing not more than 7,999 pounds, or a recreational vehicle as specified in s. 320.08(9)(c) or (d), 124 125 which is not used for hire or commercial use, who is a resident 126 of this state and who is the unremarried surviving spouse of a 127 recipient of the Purple Heart medal shall, upon application 128 therefor to the department accompanied by, with the payment of 129 the required fees, shall be issued a license plate as provided 130 in s. 320.06, on which license plate are stamped with the words

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131 "Purple Heart" and the likeness of the Purple Heart medal 132 followed by the serial number. Each application shall be 133 accompanied by proof that the applicant is the unremarried 134 surviving spouse of a recipient of the Purple Heart medal.

135 (4)Each The owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for 136 private use, a truck weighing not more than 7,999 pounds, or a 137 recreational vehicle as specified in s. 320.08(9)(c) or (d), 138 which automobile, truck, or recreational vehicle is not used for hire or commercial use, who is a resident of this the state and 139 140 a current or former member of the United States Armed Forces $_{\boldsymbol{\tau}}$ 141 and who was deployed and served in Korea during the Korean War 142 as defined in s. 1.01(14), shall, upon application to the department_{τ} accompanied by proof of active membership or former 143 active duty status during the Korean War $_{ au}$ and $_{ ext{upon}}$ payment of 144 145 the license tax for the vehicle as provided in s. 320.08, shall 146 be issued a license plate as provided by s. 320.06 upon which, 147 in lieu of the registration license number prescribed by s. 148 320.06, is shall be stamped with the words "Korean War Veteran $_{\tau}$ " 149 and a likeness of the Korean Service Medal, followed by the 150 registration license number of the plate. Proof that the 151 applicant was awarded the Korean Service Medal is sufficient to 152 establish eligibility for the license plate.

(5) <u>Each</u> The owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for private use, a truck weighing not more than 7,999 pounds, or a recreational vehicle as specified in s. 320.08(9)(c) or (d), which <u>automobile</u>, truck, or recreational vehicle is not used for

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157 hire or commercial use, who is a resident of this the state and a current or former member of the United States military, and 158 159 who was deployed and served in Vietnam during United States 160 military deployment in Indochina shall, upon application to the 161 department_{τ} accompanied by proof of active membership or former 162 active duty status during these operations, and, upon payment of 163 the license tax for the vehicle as provided in s. 320.08, shall 164 be issued a license plate as provided by s. 320.06 upon which, 165 in lieu of the registration license number prescribed by s. 166 320.06, is shall be stamped with the words "Vietnam War 167 Veteran $_{\tau}$ " and a likeness of the Vietnam Service Medal, followed 168 by the registration license number of the plate. Proof that the 169 applicant was awarded the Vietnam Service Medal is sufficient to 170 establish eligibility for the license plate.

171 Each The owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for (6) 172 private use, a truck weighing not more than 7,999 pounds, or a 173 recreational vehicle as specified in s. 320.08(9)(c) or (d), 174 which automobile, truck, or recreational vehicle is not used for 175 hire or commercial use, who is a resident of this the state and a current or former member of the United States military who was 176 177 deployed and served in Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, or another area of 178 the Persian Gulf during Operation Desert Shield or Operation 179 Desert Storm; in Afghanistan during Operation Enduring Freedom; 180 or in Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom shall, upon 181 application to the department τ accompanied by proof of active 182 membership or former active duty status during one of these

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183 operations_{τ} and upon payment of the license tax for the vehicle as provided in s. 320.08, shall be issued a license plate as 184 185 provided by s. 320.06 upon which, in lieu of the registration license number prescribed by s. 320.06, is shall be stamped with 186 the words "Operation Desert Shield," "Operation Desert Storm," 187 "Operation Enduring Freedom," or "Operation Iraqi Freedom," as 188 189 appropriate, and a likeness of the related campaign medal 190 followed by the registration license number of the plate. Proof 191 that the applicant was awarded the Southwest Asia Service Medal, 192 Iraq Campaign Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, or Global War 193 on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal is sufficient to establish 194 eligibility for the appropriate license plate.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.

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
