An act relating to airports and seaports during a state of emergency; exempting a motor vehicle owner or lessee from certain charges or penalties for parking the vehicle at an airport or seaport during a state of emergency; providing applicability; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Airports and seaports; vehicle parked during state of emergency.-
(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the owner or lessee of a motor vehicle is exempt from fees, charges, or penalties for parking the motor vehicle in a designated parking area on the premises of an airport or seaport in this state if the vehicle is otherwise lawfully parked and:
(a) The owner or lessee is detained in an area:

1. Within this state that is subject to a state of emergency declared pursuant to s. 252.36 or s. 252.38 , Florida Statutes; or
2. Outside this state that is subject to a state of emergency declared by a governing authority having jurisdiction over such area; or
(b) The airport or seaport is located in an area within

this state that is subject to a state of emergency declared pursuant to s. 252.36 or s. 252.38, Florida Statutes.
(2) This section applies only to a state of emergency declared in response to a natural or manmade disaster. The exemption granted by this section shall remain in effect until the state of emergency is terminated.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
