An unpaid intern 17 is a person who performs work for an employer under the following circumstances: 18 19 The employer is not committed to hiring the intern at (a) the conclusion of the intern's tenure. 20 21 The employer and the intern agree that the intern is 22 not entitled to wages for the work performed. 23 The work performed: (C) 1. Supplements training given in an educational 24 25 environment that may enhance the employability of the intern.

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Provides experience for the benefit of the intern.
