provider may not exceed 125 percent of the Medicare allowable
rate if:

- (a) The health care provider does not have a contract to provide medical services with the county or municipality which houses the prisoner; and
- (b) The health care provider reported a negative operating margin for the previous year to the Agency for Health Care

  Administration through hospital-audited financial data.
- (3) Compensation to an entity to provide emergency medical transportation services for a prisoner may not exceed 110 percent of the Medicare allowable rate if the entity does not have a contract with the county or municipality operating the county or municipal detention facility housing the prisoner to provide such services.
- (4) This section does not apply to charges for medical services provided at a hospital operated by the county or municipality.
