An act relating to reciprocity for the medical use of marijuana; providing that a qualified patient identification card or caregiver identification card, or its equivalent, issued by another state, United States territory, or the District of Columbia, has the same force and effect as a medical marijuana use registry identification card issued by the Department of Health; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Reciprocity for nonresident qualified patients and caregivers.—Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a qualified patient identification card or caregiver identification card, or its equivalent, issued under the laws of another state, any United States territory, or the District of Columbia, to receive marijuana or a marijuana delivery device for a medical use by a patient with a qualifying medical condition, or to permit a person to assist with the medical use of marijuana by a patient with a qualifying medical condition, shall have the same force and effect as a medical marijuana use registry identification card issued by the Department of Health pursuant to s. 381.986, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
