- (2) A person may not use a personal electronic device to play, store, or redeem a lottery ticket or game or representation thereof. However, the storage of a photographic image of a lottery ticket or game on a personal electronic device exclusively for personal use is permissible, provided the image is not used in any manner in conjunction with or in lieu of the paper ticket or game for purposes of playing or redeeming the paper ticket or game.
- (3) A person may not use or solicit the use of a personal electronic device in order to sell or purchase a lottery ticket or game or representation thereof unless the device is used exclusively to render payment for a lottery ticket or game purchased from and conveyed by an authorized retailer within the physical premises of the authorized retailer.
- (4) For purposes of this section, the term "personal electronic device" means a cellular telephone, smart phone, smart watch, tablet, laptop computer, desktop computer, or any other electronic device capable of connecting to the Internet or any other communications network or data system, but does not include a device operated solely by the department, a retailer, or a vendor, or a vending machine authorized pursuant to s. 24.112(15).
