Section 2. Subsection (4) of section 633.202, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

633.202 Florida Fire Prevention Code. -

The State Fire Marshal shall update, by rule adopted pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54, the Florida Fire Prevention Code every 3 years. Once initially adopted and subsequently updated, the Florida Fire Prevention Code shall be adopted for use statewide without adoptions by local governments and shall take effect no sooner than 6 months after the latest occurrence of the publication of the updated Florida Building Code pursuant to s. 553.73, approval by the Florida Building Commission of energy code compliance software, or the publication of the updated Florida Fire Prevention Code. When updating the Florida Fire Prevention Code, the State Fire Marshal shall consider changes made by the national model fire codes incorporated into the Florida Fire Prevention Code, the State Fire Marshal's own interpretations, declaratory statements, appellate decisions, and approved statewide and local technical amendments.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
