Paragraph (h) is added to subsection (1) of 22 section 1009.25, Florida Statutes, to read: 23 1009.25 Fee exemptions. 24 The following students are exempt from the payment of 25 tuition and fees, including lab fees, at a school district that

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provides workforce education programs, Florida College System institution, or state university:

- (h) Beginning with a pregnant student who has a conception date of January 1, 2025, or thereafter, a student who is pregnant as a result of rape or incest, who decides to carry the pregnancy to term, who provides a medical assessment or police report which provides evidence that the student is a victim of rape or incest, and whose household income level does not exceed 185 percent of the federal poverty level. The State Board of Education may adopt rules and the Board of Governors may adopt regulations regarding documentation and procedures to implement this paragraph.
- Section 2. Section 1009.8963, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
- Are Victims of Sexual Abuse Grant Program.—There is established within the Department of Education the Academic Success of Pregnant Students Who Are Victims of Sexual Abuse Grant Program.

 The purpose of the program is to provide funds for child care for low-income students who are pregnant as a result of rape or incest and who decide to carry the pregnancy to term.
 - (1) A student is eligible for the program if the student:
- (a) Is pregnant as a result of rape or incest; has a conception date of January 1, 2025, or thereafter; and decides to carry the pregnancy to term.
