2 An act relating to City of Gainesville, Alachua
3 County; providing an exception to general law;
4 authorizing the issuance of a special license to
5 mobile food dispensing vehicles to sell alcoholic
6 beverages for the consumption of alcoholic beverages
7 within a specified area; providing requirements;
8 prohibiting a licensee from selling alcoholic
9 beverages by the package for consumption outside the
10 specified area; providing for the issuance of an
11 unlimited number of licenses within specified area;
12 providing that an operator is not exempt from meeting
13 requirements to hold a license; providing boundaries;
14 providing an effective date.

16 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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18 Section 1. (1) Notwithstanding ss. 561.20 and 561.01(11),
19 Florida Statutes, in addition to any licenses that may be issued
20 under the provisions of chapter 561, Florida Statutes, a special
21 license to sell alcoholic beverages shall be issued to a mobile
22 food dispensing vehicle in a food truck park, as defined and
23 authorized in accordance with Sections 30-2.1 and 30-5.13 of the
24 City of Gainesville's Code of Ordinances (2020), located in
25 Innovation Square, and such alcoholic beverages may be consumed

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26 | by patrons within such food truck park as long as the food truck
27 | park has permanent fencing; municipal water, sewer, and solid
28 | waste; sun sails; tables; and seating. A license issued pursuant
29 | to this section does not permit the licensee to sell alcoholic
30 | beverages by the package for consumption outside of the food
31 | truck park. There is no limit on the number of special licenses
32 | issued in accordance with this act within a food truck park in
33 | Innovation Square. This act does not exempt an operator from
34 | having to otherwise meet the requirements to hold a license.

35 | (2) For the purposes of this act, "Innovation Square"
36 | means the area described as an area of land situated in Section
37 | 5, Township 10 South, Range 20 East, in the City of Gainesville,
38 | being more particularly described as follows:

40 | Begin at the intersection of the centerline of SW 6th
41 | Street with the centerline of SW 5th Avenue; thence
42 | westerly along said SW 5th Avenue to an intersection
43 | with the southerly projection of the west line of lots
44 | 14 and 15, block 7 of University Heights, as per plat
45 | thereof recorded in plat book "A", page 99 of the
46 | public records of Alachua County, Florida; thence
47 | northerly along said west line and its northerly
48 | project to an intersection with the centerline of SW
49 | 4th Avenue; thence westerly along SW 4th Avenue, to an
50 | intersection with the centerline of SW 10th Street;

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51 thence northerly along SW 10th Street, to an
52 intersection with the centerline of SW 2nd Avenue;
53 thence westerly along SW 2nd Avenue, to an
54 intersection with southerly projection on the west
55 line of Lot 20, Block 5 of University Place, as per
56 plat thereof recorded in Plat Book "A", page 77 of the
57 public records of Alachua County, Florida; thence
58 northerly along said west line and its northerly
59 projection, to the centerline of SW 1st Place; thence
60 easterly along said SW 1st Place, to an intersection
61 with the centerline of SW 10th Street; thence
62 northerly along SW 10th Street to an intersection with
63 the centerline of SW 1st Avenue; thence easterly along
64 SW 1st Avenue and its easterly projection, to an
65 intersection with the centerline of SW 6th Street;
66 thence southerly along SW 6th Street to the point of
67 beginning.

69 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
