27	program must be for the purpose of fostering the creation and			
28	expansion of agricultural businesses by young farmers and			
29	ranchers in this state.			
30	(b) The department shall select grant recipients based on			
31	selection criteria adopted pursuant to subsection (2).			
32	(2)(a) The department shall adopt rules governing the			
33	operation of the program, including an application process and			
34	selection criteria for grant recipients.			
35	(b) At a minimum, in order to be eligible to receive a			
36	grant, an individual must meet all of the following			
37	requirements:			
38	1. Be an agricultural producer, be an employee of a farm			
39	or ranch, or be an agricultural producer who is a veteran as			
40	defined in s. 1.01(14).			
41	2. Be between 18 and 35 years of age.			
42	3. Have operated a farm or ranch for not more than 10			
43	years.			
44	4. Demonstrate, at minimum, a dollar-for-dollar matching			
45	investment for the grant amount requested.			
46	5. Submit, on a form prescribed by the department, a grant			
47	application during the application period established by the			
48	department. The department may designate only one period each			
49	year for accepting applications.			
50	(3) Each grant award under the program must be between			
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51	\$5,000 and \$20,000, with no more than one award being made to an				
52	individual grant recipient per grant period.				
53	(4) Annual grant funding for this program is contingent				
54	upon specific annual appropriation by the Legislature.				
55	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.				

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
