Section 1. Paragraph (oo) is added to subsection (1) of section 456.072, Florida Statutes, to read:

456.072 Grounds for discipline; penalties; enforcement.-

- (1) The following acts shall constitute grounds for which the disciplinary actions specified in subsection (2) may be taken:
- (oo) Presenting oneself with the title of "Doctor" or the abbreviation "Dr." as a name prefix by a person licensed under chapter 464, whether orally or in writing, while rendering or advertising health care services, without disclosing that the licensee is not a medical doctor or an osteopathic physician.

Section 2. Section 456.0675, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

456.0675 Penalty for misleading identification by a health care practitioner.—In addition to, or in lieu of, any other discipline imposed pursuant to s. 456.072, presenting oneself with the title of "Doctor" or the abbreviation "Dr." as a name
