 2 An act relating to a license or permit to operate a
 3 vehicle for hire; creating s. 320.0603, F.S.;;
 4 providing that a person who holds a license issued by
 5 a county, municipality, or airport to operate a
 6 vehicle for hire may operate a vehicle for hire in any
 7 other county, municipality, or airport without being
 8 subject to certain requirements or fees under certain
 9 circumstances; defining the term "airport"; providing
 10 construction; providing an effective date.

 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 14 Section 1. Section 320.0603, Florida Statutes, is created
 15 to read:

16 320.0603 Vehicle-for-hire license or permit; reciprocity.-

17 (1) A person who holds a valid, active license or permit
 18 issued by a county or municipality to operate a vehicle for hire
 19 may operate a vehicle for hire in any other county or
 20 municipality without being subject to additional licensing or
 21 permitting requirements and without paying additional license or
 22 permit fees if the person:

23 (a) Holds a valid, active license or permit to operate a
 24 vehicle for hire in the county or municipality in which the
 25 person is domiciled; and

26 (b) Has not had a license or permit to operate a vehicle
 27 for hire suspended or revoked within the preceding 5 years.

28 (2) A person who holds a valid, active license or permit
 29 issued by an airport to operate a vehicle for hire may operate a
 30 vehicle for hire at any other airport without being subject to
 31 additional airport licensing or permitting requirements and
 32 without paying additional license or permit fees. For purposes
 33 of this subsection, the term "airport" includes an airport,
 34 airport authority, aviation authority, or other entity that
 35 operates a commercial service airport as defined in s.
 36 332.0075(1).

37 (3) This section does not grant specific authority to
 38 municipalities or special districts to regulate or license
 39 vehicles for hire which is required by s. 163.211.

40 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
