4. Is a legal resident of the county in which that person seeks to be registered; and

- 5. Registers pursuant to the Florida Election Code.
- (b) $\underline{1.}$ A person who is otherwise qualified may preregister on or after that person's 16th birthday and may vote in any election occurring on or after that person's 18th birthday.
- 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person who has preregistered pursuant to subparagraph 1. and who will be 18 years of age on or before the day of the next presidential general election may vote in the presidential preference primary for purposes of selecting a candidate for nomination for President of the United States or selecting delegates to a political party's national nominating convention. However, such person may not vote in any other race, amendment, or ballot measure that is scheduled to appear on the ballot in an election held concurrently with the presidential preference primary. Other than voting in a presidential preference primary in accordance with this subparagraph, the person is otherwise not considered an elector for purposes of this code until that person's 18th birthday.
- Section 2. Subsection (3) is added to section 98.461, Florida Statutes, to read:

pursuant to s. 103.101, the supervisor of elections must generate a separate precinct register containing the names of persons who have preregistered to vote pursuant to s. 97.041(1)(b) and who will be 18 years of age on or before the day of the next presidential general election. The precinct register must contain the same information concerning electors required by subsection (2).

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
