(3) (a) Upon conviction of a violation of this section, a person is subject to the following penalties:

- 1. For a first violation, a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. In addition, the commission shall assess an administrative fine of \$4,500 and suspend all of the violator's license privileges under this chapter for 6 months.
- 2. For a second violation, a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. In addition, the commission shall assess an administrative fine of \$9,500 and suspend all of the violator's license privileges under this chapter for 12 months.
- 3. For a third and any subsequent violation, a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. In addition, the commission shall assess an administrative fine of \$9,500 and permanently revoke all of the violator's license privileges under this chapter.
- (b) During the period of suspension or revocation of license privileges imposed under paragraph (a), the violator may not participate in the taking or harvesting, or attempt the taking or harvesting, of saltwater products from any vessel within the waters of the state; be aboard any vessel on which a commercial quantity of saltwater products is possessed through an activity requiring a license pursuant to this chapter; or engage in any other activity requiring a license, permit, or
