42 (2) A temporary certificate to practice medicine for
 43 educational purposes to help teach plastic surgery or other
 44 medical or surgical procedures to residents in a training
 45 program affiliated with a medical school that is accredited by
 46 the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education or the
 47 American Osteopathic Association or that is part of a teaching
 48 hospital, or to residents of a medical school within this state
 49 in conjunction with a nationally sponsored educational symposium
 50 or an educational symposium held by a state medical school or
 51 teaching hospital, may be issued without examination, upon
 52 verification by the board that the individual ~~meets all of the~~

54 (a) Is a graduate of an accredited medical school or its
 55 equivalent or is a graduate of a foreign medical school listed
 56 with the World Health Organization.

57 (b) Holds a valid and unencumbered license to practice
58 medicine in another state or country.

59 (c) Is a recognized expert in a specific area of plastic
60 surgery or another field of medicine or surgery, as demonstrated
61 by peer-reviewed publications, invited lectureships, and
62 academic affiliations.

63 (d) Has completed an application form adopted by the board
64 and remitted a nonrefundable application fee not to exceed \$300.

65 (e) Has not committed an act in this or any other
66 jurisdiction that would constitute a basis for disciplining a
67 physician under s. 456.072 or s. 458.331.

68 (f) Meets the financial responsibility requirements of s.
69 458.320(1) or (2).

70 (g) Is applying only in connection with a training program
71 or an educational symposium as provided in subsection (1) ~~both a~~
72 ~~medical school within this state that is accredited by the~~
73 ~~Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education and an~~
74 ~~educational symposium sponsored by the American Society of~~

77 (3) A temporary certificate issued under this section is
78 valid for up to 5 ~~no more than 3~~ days per year, and such
79 ~~certificate~~ expires 1 year after issuance.

80 (4) The department may ~~shall~~ not issue more than 12 ~~six~~
81 temporary certificates for any single educational symposium or
82 training program under this section ~~per calendar year.~~

83 (5) In order for a physician who is a graduate of a
84 foreign medical school and holds a valid and unencumbered

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85 | license to practice medicine in another country but does not
86 | hold a license to practice medicine in this or another state to
87 | obtain a temporary certificate under this section, the
88 | organization sponsoring the educational symposium must pay for
89 | any medical judgments incurred by that physician by obtaining a
90 | surety bond issued by a surety company authorized to do business
91 | in this state, by ~~or~~ establishing a certificate of deposit or a
92 | guaranteed letter of credit with a licensed and insured bank or
93 | savings institution located in the state, or by providing proof
94 | that the physician is covered under the medical malpractice
95 | insurance maintained by the teaching hospital or medical school.
96 | The amount of the bond, certificate of deposit, or guaranteed
97 | letter of credit must ~~shall~~ be at least ~~an amount not less than~~

99 | (6) A physician applying under this section is exempt from
100 | the requirements of ss. 456.039-456.046. All other provisions of
101 | chapter 456 and this chapter apply.

102 | (7) The board may ~~shall~~ not issue a temporary certificate
103 | for practice to any physician who is under investigation in
104 | another jurisdiction for an act that would constitute a
105 | violation of this chapter or chapter 456 until such time as the
106 | investigation is complete and the physician is found innocent of
107 | all charges.
